Auctions

Live Auction:

When bidding, raise your hand high for acknowledgement. If you wish to make a bid, please follow these rules:

- Make a clear gesture or shout to attract the attention of a bid spotter
- The auctioneer has the final authority on the amount for an item and/or the identity of the purchaser.

If you are the winning bidder, a runner will come to you with the buyer's form. Please fill out the information, return it to the runner. To collect your item, pay at the cashier's check out at any appropriate time. You will receive a receipt marked paid. Show this receipt to the CBA staff and they will retrieve your item.

Hunts and Trips:

The CBA has made every effort to ensure the quality of the donated hunts and/or trips. However, we cannot guarantee the success or satisfaction of either the buyer or the donor outfitter. It is the responsibility of the buyer to contact the outfitter and complete all requirements including applications and licensing in a timely manner.

Upgrading your hunts and/or trips is not required, but certainly appreciated by the outfitter. Possibly lengthen the stay, add an animal or consider bringing friends as a way to help these outfitters who are donating to help us, the CBA.

Read all hunt and trip donations carefully. Know what is included and what is not included. Surprises are rarely good. Keep copies of all communications and descriptions. Make sure that you receive a copy of your donation contract from the outfitter/guide after you purchase a hunt.

Lastly, people are interested in your experience on the hunt or trip. Write a story and give pictures to the CBA Magazine editor cbaboweditor@gmail.com. Outfitters appreciate the publicity and may be more willing to donate again to the CBA.

Silent Auction: Record your name/bidder number and bid amount on the item bid sheet. Remember that when the announcement is made to close the silent auction, no additional bids will be allowed and the bid sheets will be collected. The sheets will be tallied and winners' names posted/ announced.

Checkout:

The CBA accepts Visa, MasterCard, Cash and check. You may pay for your live and silent auction items at the end of the event. Please do not checkout until you have completed all of your purchasing for the event. Check out will be at the south end of the banquet hall. When your items have been paid for, the checkout staff will retrieve your purchases. Please do not try to retrieve the items yourself.
